ORDER GRANTING EX PARTE MOTION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF TOUSA, INC., ET AL. TO MODIFY DEADLINE

Upon consideration of the Ex Parte motion dated October 14, 2009, of The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of TOUSA, Inc., *et al.* (the "Committee") for entry of an Order extending the deadline until November 9, 2009, for all Defendants in the above-referenced Adversary Proceeding (the "Adversary Proceeding") who were served on or before October 9, 2009, within a judicial district of the United States, to file an answer or other responsive pleading (DE #19, the "Motion"), and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Motion and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is **ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The docket will reflect that Defendants in the Adversary Proceeding served on or before October 9, 2009, within a judicial district of the United States, must file an answer or other responsive pleading by November 9, 2009.
3. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
