

**Palm Beach County Tax Collectors' Motion for Extension of Time to File and for Leave to File Proof of Claim without Prejudice (the "Tax Collector Motion").**

By the Tax Collector Motion, creditor Anne M. Gannon, Tax Collector, Palm Beach County ("Tax Collector") seeks entry of an order (i) granting the Tax Collector an extension of the July 28, 2008 deadline for government entities to file proofs of claim (the "Government Bar Date") to November 15, 2008 and (ii) clarifying that the filing of any proofs of claim (each a "POC") on or before November 15, 2008 is without prejudice to further amendments of such POC.

The Tax Collector alleges that, despite diligent effort and coordination with the Debtors' tax professionals, she will not be able to establish accurate tax liabilities for the Debtors until November 2008. The Tax Collector further alleges that requiring the Tax Collector to file a POC before November 2008 will draw needless objections, which will drain the Court's time and waste judicial resources. The Tax Collector argues that because the Debtors' 2007 liabilities are already known, and the 2008 liabilities can be estimated, the Debtors will not be prejudiced by the Tax Collector's desired extension.
