

**Debtors' Fifth Motion to Reject Certain Unexpired Leases and Executory Contracts (the "Rejection Motion").**

By the Rejection Motion, the Debtors seek entry of an order authorizing them to reject certain leases (the "Leases") and executory contracts (the "Executory Contracts" and, together with the Leases, the "Agreements") that, in the Debtors' opinion, are no longer beneficial to the Debtors' estates.

The Leases fall into the following categories: (i) equipment leases; and (ii) office space leases. The Executory Contracts fall into the following categories: (i) development contracts; (ii) service agreements; (iii) an employment agreement; (iv) a performance and maintenance agreement; and (v) purchase and sale agreements.

After reviewing the Agreements and, to the extent possible, attempting to renegotiate the terms of certain Agreements, the Debtors have concluded that the Agreements are not necessary for the Debtors' successful reorganization and, therefore, that rejection of the Agreements is in the best interest of the Debtors and their estates.
