

Debtors' Seventh Motion to Reject Certain Unexpired Leases and Executory Contracts (the "Rejection Motion").

By the Rejection Motion, the Debtors seek entry of an order authorizing them to reject a lease (the "Lease") and certain executory contracts (the "Executory Contracts" and, together with the Lease, the "Agreements") that, in the Debtors' opinion, are no longer beneficial to the Debtors' estates.

The Lease to be rejected is a lease of a copy machine used in the ordinary course of the Debtors' businesses. The Executory Contracts fall into the following categories: (i) communication agreements for services such as internet and telephone; and (iii) a purchase and sale agreement for real property in a development known as North Point.

After reviewing the Agreements and, to the extent possible, attempting to negotiate favorable modifications to the terms of certain Agreements, the Debtors have concluded that the Agreements are not necessary for the Debtors' successful reorganization and, therefore, rejection of the Agreements is in the best interest of the Debtors and their estates.

A hearing on the Rejection Motion has been scheduled for October 23, 2008, with an objection deadline of October 17, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. (ET).
