

Debtors' Eighth Motion to Reject Certain Unexpired Leases and Executory Contracts (the "Rejection Motion").

By the Rejection Motion, the Debtors seek entry of an order authorizing them to reject a lease (the "Lease") and an executory contracts (the "Executory Contract" and, together with the Lease, the "Agreements") that, in the Debtors' opinion, are no longer beneficial to the Debtors' estates.

The Lease to be rejected is a lease of postage machines used in the ordinary course of the Debtors' businesses. The Executory Contract is a services agreement to provide tracking and managing statistics as well as online marketing metrics.

After reviewing the Agreements and, to the extent possible, attempting to negotiate favorable modifications to the terms of certain Agreements, the Debtors have concluded that the Agreements are not necessary for the Debtors' successful reorganization and, therefore, rejection of the Agreements is in the best interest of the Debtors and their estates.

A hearing on the Rejection Motion has been scheduled for December 4, 2008, with an objection deadline of November 28, 2008.
