

Motion for an Order Extending 90-Day Period Within Which the Debtors May Remove Civil Actions Under 28 U.S.C. § 1452 and Bankruptcy Rule 9027(a) (the “Removal Motion”).

By the Removal Motion, the Debtors seek the entry of an order extending their time to file notices of removal of the numerous civil state and federal court actions or proceedings (the “Court Actions”), that they are party to which were pending as of January 29, 2008 (the “Petition Date”), until and including July 27, 2008. The removal period is currently set to expire on April 28, 2008. The notices of removal will effectuate a change of jurisdiction from the court where the Court Actions are currently pending to the Bankruptcy Court.

According to the Removal Motion, the Debtors and their management have begun the process of determining whether removal is appropriate with respect to the Court Actions. The Debtors assert that these Court Actions are often managed at the division level and the analysis related to removal actions involves coordination with separate local counsel who represented the Debtors prior to the Petition Date. The Debtors argue that this analysis requires the time and attention of key employees who are currently focused other aspects of the Debtors’ chapter 11 cases. Therefore, the Debtors request additional time to file notices of removal with respect to the Court Actions.

A hearing on the Removal Motion has been scheduled for April 9, 2008, with an objection deadline of April 4, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. (ET).
