

Debtors' Sixth Motion to Reject Certain Unexpired Leases and Executory Contracts (the "Rejection Motion").

By the Rejection Motion, the Debtors seek entry of an order authorizing them to reject certain leases (the "Leases") and executory contracts (the "Executory Contracts" and, together with the Leases, the "Agreements") that, in the Debtors' opinion, are no longer beneficial to the Debtors' estates.

The Leases to be rejected are leases of copy machines used in the ordinary course of the Debtors' businesses. The Executory Contracts fall into the following categories: (i) broker agreements; (ii) landscaping agreements; and (iii) purchase and sale agreements.

After reviewing the Agreements and, to the extent possible, attempting to negotiate the terms of certain Agreements, the Debtors have concluded that the Agreements are not necessary for the Debtors' successful reorganization and, therefore, that rejection of the Agreements is in the best interest of the Debtors and their estates.

A hearing on the Rejection Motion has been scheduled for September 17, 2008, with an objection deadline of September 12, 2008 at 5:00 p.m.
